1. Based on 10-point evaluation with 5 being an average score assigned.
 2. Evaluation from Region should include consideration for:

 - b. Parents occupation
- III. Leadership and Character (Judged from Parts C, E and F of Form) **25%**
1. Club memberships and extracurricular activities
 2. Leadership positions held
 3. Honors and awards received
 4. Work experience
- IV. Participation in Texas High School Rodeo (Judged from Parts C, E and F) **25%**

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Currently enrolled and actively participating in THSRA
2. Ranked in the upper ½ of class
3. Currently enrolled in public school or an accredited home school program
4. Have completed scholarship application turned in by deadline.
