“DREAM TEAM” FANTASY RODEO

May 8, 2011

Teams will be made up of one contestant from each of the 12 events:

BB SW BK SB BA CR GT RR PL HD HL BR

- ❖ There will be 15 teams per bracket – one team for each of the top 15 positions that qualify for the Finals.
- ❖ Team positions have been randomly drawn (see back of the page.) After final standings are audited following the Lubbock rodeo, contestant names will be added to each team in their corresponding positions.
- ❖ In the event of a tie within the Top 15, the higher position will be decided based on seniority. A coin toss will be the second tie-breaker, if needed.
- ❖ In the event of a tie for the 15th position, seniority will prevail. A coin toss will be the second tie-breaker, if needed. Any positions below 15th will not be placed on a team and, therefore, any points earned by these contestants will not go towards any team’s standings.
- ❖ If a qualifier chooses not to enter the Finals, all contestants below will be moved up and assigned a new position number.
- ❖ In the events that do not have 15 qualifiers, those who enter will be repeated, in order, until all 15 positions are filled. Using bareback as an example: the four contestants will be repeated for positions 5, 6, 7 & 8 and again for 9, 10, 11 & 12. The first three will fill positions 13, 14 & 15.

Teams are \$30 each and will be sold in brackets. Fifteen teams (one of each) make up a bracket. A bracket must fill (all 15 teams sold) before the next bracket is opened. Sales will end at the conclusion of the second performance on Saturday night.

Unsold positions in the last bracket will belong to Tri-State. They may be swapped with sold positions in other brackets to evenly disperse Tri-State’s teams.

Teams will be drawn for each player and posted before the start of the third go round. You will not get to pick your team. FYI: If you like to win, be prepared to cheer against your children. There is no guarantee they will be on your team.

Because there is a chance that someone could be swapped to the last bracket to replace an unsold team, we cannot draw teams until the sales deadline has passed.

Only scores from the third go round (Sunday’s performance) will be used to tabulate team totals. Points earned by the contestants for the third go only will be awarded to their respective teams.

The first place team from each bracket will earn a 50% payback. The other 50% goes to Tri-State. (Remember, this is a fundraiser.)

This is more or less a “trial run” to see if it will work which is why we are only using one go round’s scores. If all goes well, we will expand it next year to all three rounds and the average. This is replacing the silent auction we have had in the past so I hope it gets lots of support. You do not have to be a member or related to a member to play. If you have friends who like to play other fantasy sports, ask them to try out our game.
